In the attention of UPT students and employees

As a result of the spread of infection with the new Coronavirus (COVID-19) in Europe, we inform the UPT Community the followings:

The DSP Timis communication with the established measures and the evaluation and localization questionnaires on the Romanian territory.

If there are persons from the areas specified in the DSP Timis press release, they will complete the questionnaire and will be presented urgently to the family doctor or as follows:

- UPT students at the POLICLINICA STUDENTEASCA (Aleea Studenţilor No.1),
- UPT employees at the LABOUR MEDICINE CABINET (house 2 MV, et. I, room 15), to be highlighted.

In the case of UPT students, the absences accumulated during the 14-day isolation period at home will be motivated, if case, and the fulfillment of the activities shall be done tax free.

The presence, together with the annexes, is communicated to the UPT entities in order to disseminate information among the UPT community.

In order to implement the measures established by the Ministry of Health for the control and prevention of infection with the new Coronavirus (COVID-19), the Directorate of Public Health Timis instituted the following measures:

- provides medical personnel (24/24 hours) at the border crossing points and at the "Traian Vuia" International Airport in Timisoara;
- the medical personnel perform the epidemiological triage of all travelers arriving from areas where they have been reported diseases with the new Coronavirus (COVID-19), mainland China and Italy:

Localities in the Province of Lombardy and in the Veneto Region:

Euganeo's voice

- Codogno
- Castiglione d'Adda
- Casalpusterlengo
- Fombio
- Male
- Somaglia
- Bertonico
- Newfoundland of the Passerini
- Castelgerundo
- San Fiorano

City of Piemont Region:

- Cumiana

All these persons complete the questionnaire elaborated by the Ministry of Health, in which they record, the area in which they traveled, the period of the trip and if they show signs of acute respiratory disease;

For travelers returning from Italy:

- If they have traveled in the last 14 days in the following localities: Vo Euganeo, Codogno, Castiglione d'Adda, Casarpusterlengo, Fombio, Maleo, Somaglia, Bertonico, Terranova dei Passerini, Castegerundo and San Forano in the Lombardy and Veneto area, Cumiana in the Peimonte region these persons will be quarantined in the quarantine centers identified in our county for a period of 14 days and will be monitored daily by DSPJ Timis staff.

- Persons who, when presenting at the border points, show signs of illness and have visited the above localities, will be sent for specialized investigations to the "Victor Babes" Hospital of Timisoara.
- For travelers who have been to other localities in the regions of Lombardy, Veneto and the Piemont region, than the above-mentioned ones, it is recommended to insulate at home for a period of 14 days and will be monitored daily by the staff DSPJ Timis;
- For travelers who were in other areas of Italy than the ones in point 3, there are no measures required for isolation at home until now.
- For travelers returning from China, the measures previously established with isolation 14 days at home and monitoring by DSPJ personnel remain in force.

We also recommend that the general population comply with the general measures for the prevention of airway disease, namely:

- avoiding crowded and crowded closed spaces (eg supermarkets, malls);
- keeping a distance of at least 1 meter from any person with respiratory symptoms (eg cough, sneezing);
- frequent washing of hands, using soap and water when the hands are visibly dirty or alcohol-based antiseptic if the hands are not visibly dirty;
- use of the technique of coughing or squeezing inside the bent elbow or covering the nose and mouth during coughing and sneezing with a napkin.
- -single use, followed by its disposal after use and IMMEDIATE washing of hands with soap and water;
- abstention from touching the mouth, nose and eyes;
- -compliance with the rules on how to wear, remove and remove the masks associated with proper hand hygiene after removal.

The Timis County Public Health Department communicates daily, through press releases, data on the evolution of the situation at international level and other measures ordered by the Romanian authorities, depending on the daily epidemiological situation.
