The Research and Development Station for Viticulture and Enology Blaj (RDSVE) co-ordinates and conducts research and production activities to meet national needs in accordance with European legislation and international standards and practices.

Research Station of Viticulture and Enology Blaj was founded in year 1946, in the village of Craciunelul de Jos whilst the viticulture studies started here have represented the bases for the development of viticulture in Transylvania.

At the time being, the station develops its activity in the following directions:

1. Scientific research in the fields of: viticulture, vinification, directly referring to genetics and improvement of viticulture varieties, production of planting material with high biological value, agro-techniques and viticulture ecology, agro-chemistry, physiology and biochemistry, protection of plants, land survey, vinification, wine chemistry and microbiology.
2. The activity of research development and assessment is based mainly on the cultivation of vine and production of high quality white wines for inner and international market. Recently, we have been mostly investigating natural resistance (glucosinolates, epicuticular wax, colour) of vegetables and field crops to insect pest attack, testing different environmentally acceptable methods in controlling field crop pests (wireworms, Colorado potato beetle, cereal leaf beetle, thrips etc.) under field (such as biofumigation, intercropping, wood ash, essential oils etc.) and laboratory conditions, studying the occurrence and efficacy of indigenous beneficials (such as entomopathogenic nematodes and fungi, parasitoids, predatory mites etc.) in controlling important pests of cultivated and wild-growing plants, testing the potential synergism between environmentally acceptable control methods. In the field of phytopathology we are researching the distribution and economic impact of Fusarium species on winter wheat. In a connection to grassland management the group investigate the specific relationships between grass sward and soil parameters on sown and native grasslands and also interactions between grazing animals and herbaceous plants on karst pastures. It is recognized that interactions between soil erosion processes and biodiversity are significant, and a comprehensive level approach to their assessment must be taken. Agriculture strongly affects the rate and types of hillslope processes, and the way in which farmland is managed can dramatically influence whether soil erosion remains at an acceptable level. Management practices with detrimental effects on soil biodiversity lead to a rapid decline in soil structure and degradation of the resource base. Because the nutrient reserves of most soils are predominantly concentrated in the upper layer, the loss of top soil has drastic impacts on productivity. Maintenance of a high level of soil organic matter content is crucial to the enhancement of soil structure and other life-support processes and in environmental regulatory mechanisms. High soil organic matter content and favorable soil structure depend on the activity and species diversity of soil fauna. The activity of soil microfauna is critical to the maintenance of favorable soil structure and mineral cycling.

The European Agriculture-Plant Microbiomes: biotechnological applications for health, the environment and for a sustainable agriculture of the future

Description of the project offered:

The team "Biotechnology of Rhizospheric Bacteria" of the Instituto Valenciano de Investigaciones Agrarias (IVal, Spain), led by the Dr. Ramon Penyalver is proposing a project entitled "The European Agriculture-Plant Microbiome: biotechnological applications for human health, the environment and for a sustainable agriculture of the future". The main goal of this multidisciplinary project is to obtain, analyze, exploit and manipulate the rhizospheric microbiota and their corresponding genomes (rhizospheric microbiome) of main agricultural plants in order to develop new biotechnological products, not only for improving the production and competitiveness of the European crops, but also to develop new biotechnological products for other industrial applications. This will be achieved by the isolation of the rhizospheric plant microbiota and its subsequent phenotypic and genetic characterization according to those traits that could contribute to plant growth promotion, environmental aspects or human health. All isolates will be clustered according to the performed analyses and representative isolates will be tested in planta in greenhouse bioassays. Meanwhile, by the use of metagenomics (DNA and rRNA libraries), metatranscriptomic (mRNA) and metaproteomics (proteins) we will identify all microbial diversity present in the plant microbiota (bypassing isolation and culturability) as well as those expressed genes and proteins present in the plant rhizospheres in order to identify novel functional genes or proteins. Candidate new genes or proteins will be used as probes for screening the whole collection of isolates (microbiota). Potential isolates or products will be further evaluated and promising microorganisms or novel products will be developed by biotechnological companies for commercialization of new bioproducts.

International Research Staff Exchange Scheme (IRSES)



What is International Research Staff Exchange Scheme IRSES?

IRSES, International Research Staff Exchange Scheme aims to strengthen research partnerships between European research organizations and research organizations from countries with which the EC has an S&T agreement (see below), through staff exchange and networking activities. Participants are non profit public or private research organisations which receive support from the European Commission to establish or reinforce long-term cooperation with countries outside Europe research organizations. An IRSES partnership shall be composed of at least two independent participants based in two different European country, and one or more organizations based in a non-European country.

What are the eligible countries?

Non European research organizations must be based in a country with which the EC has an S&T agreement or a country covered by the European Neighbourhood Policy :

Algeria, Argentina, Armenia, Australia, Azerbaijan, Belarus, Brazil, Canada, China, Chile, Egypt, Georgia, India, Japan, Jordan, Lebanon, Libya, Mexico, Moldova, Morocco, Palestinian-administrated areas, New Zealand, ep. of Korea, Russia, South Africa, Syria, Tunisia, Ukraine and USA.
